【思高本】所以,我们既有如此众多如云的证人,围绕着我们,就该卸下各种累赘和纠缠人的罪过, 以坚忍的心,跑那摆在我们面前的赛程,

【牧灵本】既然有众多如云的见证人围绕在我们四周,我们就应该除去所有的重担和罪恶的纠缠,坚 持不懈地奔赴我们的前程!

【现代本】既然我们有这么多见证人,像云彩一样围绕着我们,就应该排除一切的障碍和跟我们纠缠 不休的罪,坚忍地奔跑在我们前头的路程。

【当代版】我们既有这许多的见证人像云彩一般围绕着,我们就当卸下一切重担,摆脱容易缠累我们 的罪,坚心忍耐,奔跑前程;

【牧灵本】当然,我们在接受管教时总不舒服,甚至痛苦。可是我们经过训练之后,必能结出果实, 那就是义德与和平。

【现代本】我们受管教的时候,闷闷不乐;可是后来,那些因受管教而经历过锻炼的人能够结出平安 的果子,过着正直的生活。

KJV Follow peace with all men, and holiness, without which no man shall see the Lord:

\[BBE \] Let your desire be for peace with all men, and to be made holy, without which no man may see the Lord;

ASV Follow after peace with all men, and the sanctification without which no man shall see the Lord:

【思高本】又应该慎,免得有人疏忽天主的恩宠,免得苦根子长出来,而累及你们,使许多人因此蒙 受玷污。

【牧灵本】要谨慎,切莫使任何人失去天主的恩宠,避免有苦根的植物影响你们、腐蚀你们。

【现代本】要谨慎,免得有人失去了神的恩典。要谨慎,免得有人像一株有毒的植物,长大起来,遗 害人群。

【当代版】你们又要谨慎,恐怕有人失去了神的恩典,又有毒根生出来,造成混乱,就污染多人。

KJV Looking diligently lest any man fail of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby many be defiled;

[NIV] See to it that no one misses the grace of God and that no bitter root grows up to cause trouble and defile many.

\[BBE] Looking with care to see that no man among you in his behaviour comes short of the grace of God; for fear that some bitter root may come up to be a trouble to you, and that some of you may be made unclean by it;

[ASV] looking carefully lest there be any man that falleth short of the grace of God; lest any root of bitterness springing up trouble you, and thereby the many be defiled;

KJV Lest there be any fornicator, or profane person, as Esau, who for one morsel of meat sold his birthright.

INIV See that no one is sexually immoral, or is godless like Esau, who for a single meal sold his inheritance rights as the oldest son.

BBE And that there may not be any evil liver, or any man without respect for God, like Esau, who let his birthright go for a plate of food.

【ASV】 lest there be any fornication, or profane person, as Esau, who for one mess of meat sold his own birthright.
